GRICUA 2020 District Days - CANCELLED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE DUE TO COVID-19

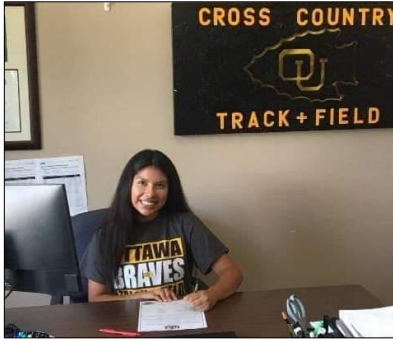
