Customers will pre-pay for their electricity and receive daily text or email notifications of the amount used and balance remaining on their account. Be IN CONTROL with a GRICUA Pre-Pay Account.

- Has fallen below your requested threshold balance and when you successfully make a
- Is eligible for disconnection, has been disconnected, or has been reconnected.
